

## Secora.Care Assembly Technician Job Description

Secora is a fast-paced, early-stage company that is introducing a groundbreaking solution to help the 12.4M elderly people who live by themselves in the United States. We use “big data” to monitor, trend, and alert on important medical and safety issues. Our ultimate goal is to provide an easy-to-use, evidence-based answer to the very personal question: “Can my mother still live safely by herself?” We currently offer our solution to Personal Care Services (PCS) Agencies, allowing them to provide a “high tech” solution that complements their “high touch” care services. Our solution gives them unique competitive differentiation, and the ability to attract and retain more clients.

This data is provided by our patented sensors that measure the elders’ activities, falls, and “sounds of daily living”. Importantly, all of this data is measured passively – the elder doesn’t have to wear anything or do anything different, which is particularly important if the elder has dementia. These wireless sensors provide real time data from the bathroom, kitchen, living room and bedroom to our cloud-based analytics engine. The ability to sense both sound and activity results in our ability to gain exceptional insights into how someone lives. For example: Did the doorbell ring, and subsequently, were there visitors? Did the microwave oven beep along with activity in the kitchen? How long does it take the elder to answer the phone? How often does the sink, shower, or bathtub run? How often does the toilet flush? From just these few examples one can see how we can infer if the elder is socializing, eating, how well she can hear, how mobile she is, etc.

We are looking for *kind, hard working and smart* Assembly Technicians to join our team. You will work with a technical supervisor to assemble and test components, devices (combinations of components) and systems (combinations of devices). You will also rework devices, package and ship systems, and conduct other assembly tasks as request by your supervisor. Attention to detail is extremely important; older peoples lives may be depending on the quality of your work! Your success will be judged on your work quality (<1% failure rate of assembled devices) and your speed (<15 min per assembly minimum, <10 min ideal).
